In 1978 I obtained a Master of Science degree from Syracuse University in Computer and Information Sciences. I retired from IBM in 1994 as a Senior Engineer.

While I continued my trombone playing for several years in several amateur community organizations, the lack of talent eventually caused me to sell the beast at a garage sale in the mid 70's. Oh well, it provided a lot of interesting experiences over the years.
